I. **Opening of Meeting:** Pledge of Allegiance

II. Reading of Reports:

A. Head of Charter Organization: No Report.

B. Troop Committee Chair: Reminder that adult leaders are required to have completed the new YPT. Also, all adult leaders must complete their role training.

 - JLOW: Mr. Martin notified the committee that the council is discontinuing the JLOW. Mr. Martin to search for alternatives.
 - Next year's shotgun trip the boys who participated last year can complete their practical in the May session to obtain the shotgun merit badge.
 - SM (and Asst SM) Training Mr. Martin, Mr. Joneleit, and Mr. Koutsoftas will need to complete the second part of training in the Spring or at Summer camp.
