- There was a Pinewood Derby Tutorial given by Richard, Ian and Varnith. Received good feedback from the packs. Derby will be coming up on January 21st and will need scouts to help run the event that day.
- The ECOH will be Saturday, January 7th for Costa K., Ryan D., Michael B., and Aidan J. All scouts are required to attend and help with set up and clean up. We plan to present Mr. Ryan with his walking stick gift and we're updating the script.
- Klondike Derby will be on January 28th. We need a meeting to pull together teams. Older boys need to be encouraged to take the lead. Need to purchase more sticks for lashings.
- High Adventure
 - o Philmont 2023: 2 crews with 5 adults and 6 boys in each crew at the moment. The total cost is about \$3,500/person. Payments will be due in December, February, April (\$700 each payment) and depending on final costs and Pancake Breakfast fundraiser, final payment in June will be calculated. Leaders and crews have been determined and Mr. Ryan will be invited to attend a meeting to give pointers on surviving Philmont.
