### **G. Outdoor Activities Coordinator:**

- Shotgun Trip (June 14)
  - o 30 boys, 17 adults

  - Mrs. Keating, Mrs. Helgeson and Mr. Rolston will be bringing grills

- Summer Camp
  - o Kids: 37 boys
  - Adults: 5 adults
  - Physicals: most parents will need to submit new forms.
    - Medications: must be in original packaging and reviewed at medical.
  - Extra shirts can be bought during the weekly meeting. Once school ends, T-shirts will be locked up in the school, and we will not have access.
  - O Trading shirts at camp maybe bring a few (2 M, 2 L, 2 XL or whatever extra sizes we have) or other swag.

# L. Equipment Coordinator:

- Solar panel on container needs to be replaced. It should cost \$150 to replace can be switched out in September.
- Set up a day in July to clean out and organize the container.

- Inventory for summer camp
  - o Need 3 working lanterns, and propane canisters (1 canister, per lantern, per night)
    - Half some half-filled propane containers. Get a gadget to combine two half filled ones.
    - Bring big propane tank with extra hoses to connect to multiple devices.
  - o Maybe get solar lights for the pathway to toilet.
  - o Rechargeable battery with LED lanterns?
    - We have two batteries already. Can alternate charging the batteries at the adult lounge.
- First Aid Kits
  - One for Sea Base (sunscreen, aloe, bandages are important). Adult leaders should review what's in it.
  - One for Summer Camp
