

## Tent Care:

Scouts are responsible for maintaining all troop equipment they use on every camping trip.

Tents are assigned to scouts to be cleaned and dried after every use. They are often taken down and packed in the morning when they may still be damp. If possible, when arriving home after an outing, scouts should take the tents out of the tent bag. They can be set up in a garage or in the back yard to dry. All leaves, dirt, etc. should be swept out of the tent. If needed, a garden hose can also be used to clean the tent and then allow to completely dry. Tents should never be “washed” in a machine. Do not use any detergents when cleaning tents, as this will ruin the water repellent properties of the fabric. Tarps (Rain Flies) and the plastic Ground Cloths should also be cleaned and dried as well.

*Once thoroughly dried*, the tent and all of the other contents should be rolled and repacked back into the tent bag. Tents should be returned at the next troop meeting.

**Important:** Please write down on the “Tent Report” the tent number and print the name of the scout who cleaned the tent. Also, list any issues found with any of the contents (*missing or broken items*). This report is to be given to Mr. Beacco or to another adult leader, upon returning the tent. We need to be sure that the tent is ready for the next camping trip.

All tents are numbered and the number on the outside of the Tent Bag is the number of the tent. *Some tents may have different numbers listed on some of the contents inside the bag.*

### Every tent bag should include the following items:
